Preflight Action

Items to include while performing the preflight inspection:

1. Do not rely entirely in fuel gauges, autopilot and the GPS

2. Don't feel pressured to fly

3. Avoid distractions in the cockpit

4. Always use your checklist

5. Make sure preventive and required maintenance inspections have been performed

A pre-flight checklist is crucial and should include checking the forecasted weather and also performing an inspection of the interior and the exterior of the airplane.
